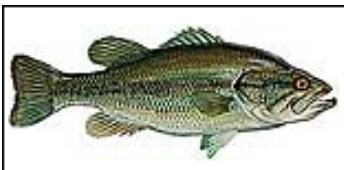

The **largemouth bass** (*Micropterus salmoides*) is in the sunfish family. It is marked by a series of dark, blotches forming a jagged horizontal stripe along each side. It is the largest of the black basses with a record overall length of (38 in), and a weight of 25 lbs. Use live minnows, worms, crickets and crayfish. Plastic worms and artificial flies and lures also are popular.

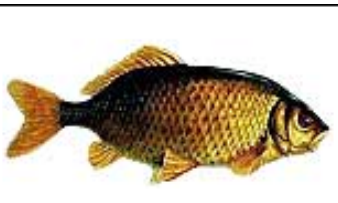

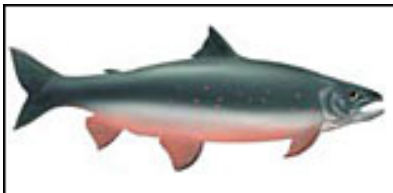
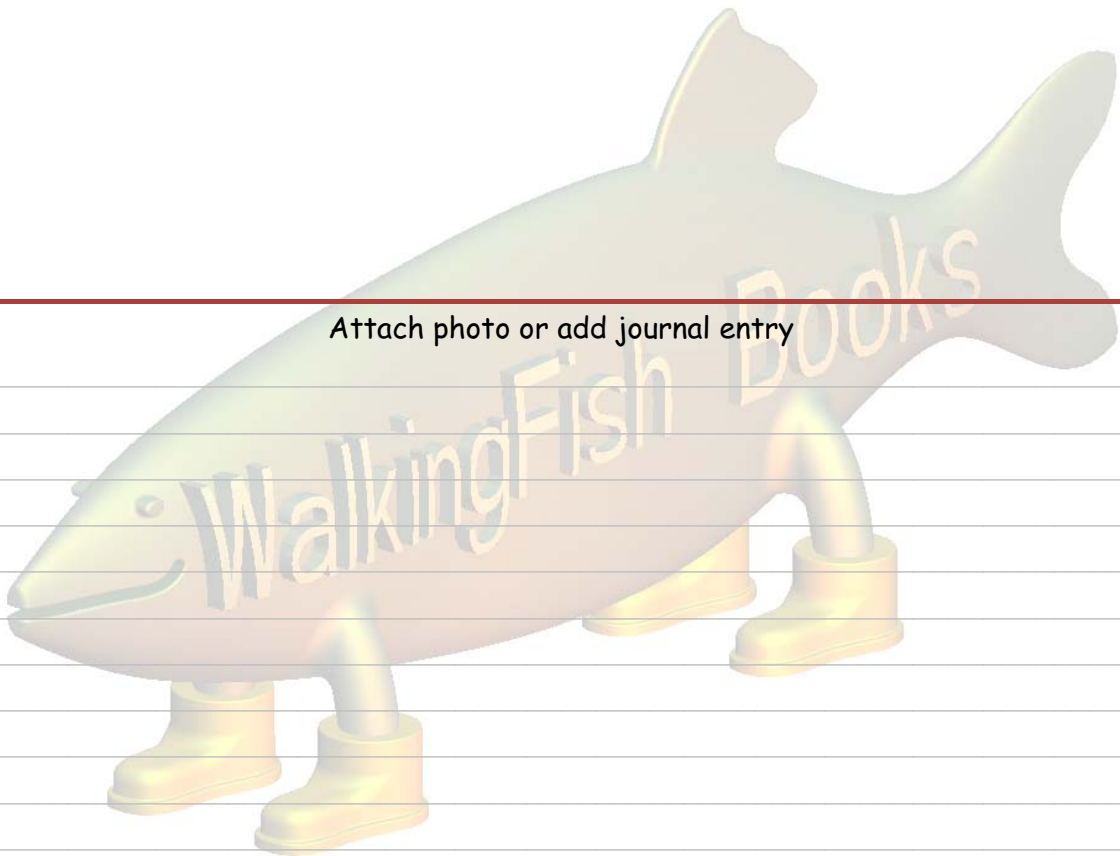

**Arctic char** (*Salvelinus alpinus*) is both a freshwater and saltwater fish, native to Arctic, sub-Arctic and alpine lakes and coastal waters. No other freshwater fish is found as far north. The flesh color of char varies; it can range from a bright red to a pale pink.

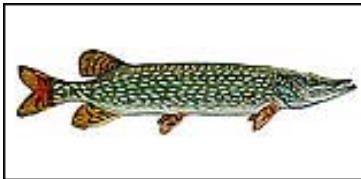

The **northern pike** (*Esox lucius*), is a species of carnivorous fish. Pike are found in sluggish streams and shallow, weedy places in lakes, as well as in cold clear rocky waters. Pike grow to lengths of 59 ins. and weigh up to 55 lbs. Pike are olive, shading into yellow to white along the belly. The flank is marked with short, light bar-like spots with dark spots on the fins. Use dead baits, live baits and lure fishing to catch these hard-fighting fish.

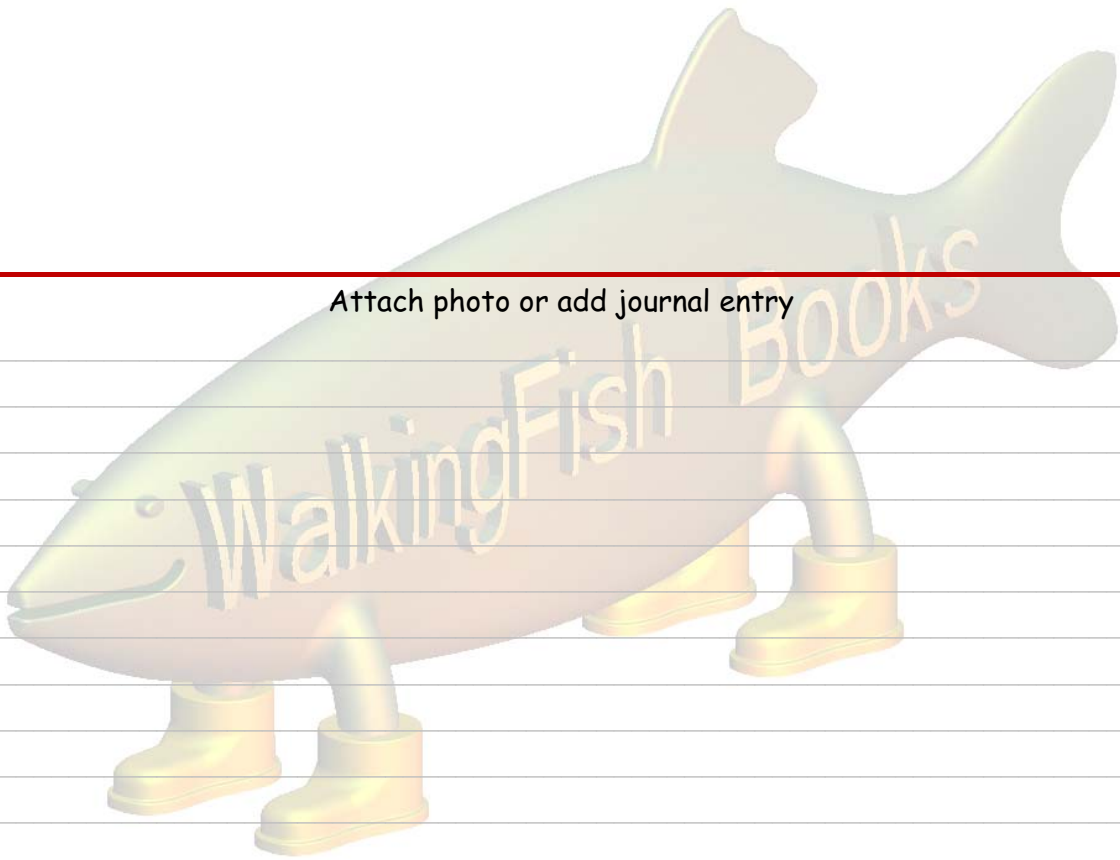

The **rainbow trout** (*Oncorhynchus mykiss*) is a species of salmonid. Rainbows range from 12-36 ins. in length. The world record rainbow was 43.6 lbs. Rainbow trout have a broad red band along their sides. Rainbows stay in fresh water their whole lives. Fish them with worms, grasshoppers, crickets, salmon eggs, and artificial lures. They are a favorite with fly fishers.
